CHARDONNAY, WALTER HANSEL, Estate, Cuvée Alyce, Russian River Valley, 2007

The 2007 Chardonnay Cuvée Alyce is sensational. Named after Stephen Hansel's recently deceased 90-year-old mother, the wine has admirable minerality, plenty of honeysuckle, hints of pear, white peach, and pineapple, a deep, full-bodied mouthfeel with subtle smokiness from oak, very good acidity, and a long, concentrated finish. PINOT NOIR, WALTER HANSEL, Estate, The Three Rows, Russian River Valley, Sonoma, 2007

From the original three rows planted in 1978. Seductively perfumed bouquet of raspberry jam, rose, magnolia, Asian spices and minerals. Impressively pure red fruit flavors stain the palate, with silky tannins adding back-end grip. The spiciness builds on the finish, which leaves sweet red and dark berry notes behind. ☀ ZINFANDEL, TURLEY, Duarte Vineyard, Contra Costa County, 2008

The 2008 Zinfandel Duarte Vineyard from the Contra Costa appellation exhibits plenty of loamy soil notes intermixed with sweet kirsch, licorice, and lavender in its Rhone Valley-like personality. It reveals abundant texture, a supple, full-bodied mouthfeel, and a layered finish. As always, a mind-boggling array of Zinfandels has been produced by the world's premier Zinfandel specialist, Larry Turley. He deserves remarkable credit for his "holy grail" quest to locate largely forgotten parcels of old Zinfandel vines, and preserve as many of these historic sites as possible. Robert Parker

As always, a mind-boggling array of Zinfandels has been produced by the world's premier Zinfandel specialist, Larry Turley. He deserves remarkable credit for his "holy grail" quest to locate largely forgotten parcels of old Zinfandel vines, and preserve as many of these historic sites as possible. Like most Zinfandels, Turley's are best drunk during their first 5-6 years of life, although in certain vintages, some wines can handle a decade worth of cellaring. However, the glory of Zinfandel is its youthful, exuberant, flamboyant, spicy, peppery, briery fruit. It will not achieve greater complexity or flavor dimension by extended cellaring. All of these Zinfandels come from dry-farmed vineyards, a majority of them being old head-pruned sites planted by Italian immigrants in the late 19th century.
